As for the payment due on April 1, 2020, it is important to note that it will have to be withdrawn as usual since it is the first payment of the 2020-2021 policy and gives effect to your renewal.

Important information regarding loss of revenue

Many of you are wondering whether the loss of income caused by the closure of your establishments by civil authorities could be the subject of a claim under your insurance policy. As mentioned in the contract, only the loss of income generated by the closure of your buildings caused by an admissible claim is covered. Unfortunately, the spread of the COVID-19 virus is not an insured loss under the policy.
